Band Boosters and Understanding Fair Share

Welcome back to all returning members and a big welcome to all our new members! This letter outlines the cost to participate in the East Lake High School band program.

Pinellas County School Board provides some funds to operate the band program at our school. (Our program includes marching band, orchestra, wind and jazz ensembles.) The funds received from the referendum contribute to the cost of purchasing music, instruments, technology, band uniforms, and miscellaneous other necessities. Unfortunately the PSCB funds are not sufficient to cover all of the costs of the entire band program. This is where the fair-share becomes necessary. The purpose of the fair share for band is to help spread the financial responsibility for the band program equally between the students. The fair share amount of each ensemble represents only a portion of the actual student cost for participation, with the Band Booster fundraising providing the balance of necessary funds to provide a robust, enriching program for our students. Currently our main sourcing of booster funds include the following:

- (1) **Sponsorships**: Area businesses sponsor the East Lake Silver Sound for as little as \$50. Their sponsorships include and ad in the Classic program as well as a link on the East Lake band's website. Sponsorship forms are available on the East Lake Band's website.
- (2) **Concession sales at the ELHS football games**: Operating the concession stand is a significant source of funds and we depend on the band parents to participate with this operation during home varsity, junior varsity, and powderpuff football games.
- (3) **East Lake Classic**: Each year our marching band hosts bands from across the state for a marching band competition. The event is a major source of funds for our program. The amount of money raised depends on the numbers of bands that compete in the show. Every band student and his/her family needs to assist with this event. Sources of income from the Classic include ticket sales, concessions, "shout outs", bake sale, and ads in the Classic program.
- (4) **FFCC**: Similar to the Classic, the band hosts color guards from across the state for a color guard competition. This event is also a major source of funds for our program. The amount of money raised depends on the numbers of guards that compete. Every **band student and his/her family** needs to assist with this event. Sources of income include ticket sales, concessions, and "shout outs".
- (5) Tag Days and Spirit Nights: These fundraising opportunities are scheduled throughout the year.
 - a. A Tag Day is when band members stand in from of a retail store and ask for contributions from the store's patrons. Students often play music.
 - b. Spirit Nights are fun family activities where a restaurant will donate a percentage of the profit to our band for anyone eating at the restaurant. Each restaurant has specific requirements so the 'rules' will vary.

VOLUNTEER NEEDS

To help offset student costs, the boosters fundraise for our music program throughout the year. We need parents and family members to be active within our booster organization for a variety of tasks. We meet monthly on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 pm. Monthly meetings give us the opportunity to regroup and direct ourselves to do what is needed to support our kids. We are always seeking new fundraising ideas and the parents/family members to help organize and administer them. Successful music programs around the country are always fueled by a robust booster organization. - Winter Program (percussion and guard): transportation to/from competition, music, instruction, uniforms (guard)

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Paying Fair Share

We offer the following methods to pay your fair-share.

- (1) Check [Place in blue barrel in Mr. Black's office. This option is only available when the band room is open.]
- (2) Paypal [a Paypal link is listed below]

Paypal Option 1:

By clicking on the new "Pay Now" button on the bottom of this page, you will directed to a secure site linked to the East Lake Band Booster's account. There, you can sign into your Paypal account to make a payment or use the guest tab to pay by credit card. After answering the appropriate questions about the method and purpose of payment, hit send and your payment will be made.

Paypal Option 2 (preferred Paypal method):

- 1. Rather than using the "Make a Payment" link, establish and use your own PayPal account.
- 2. Sign in to your personal account at www.paypal.com and then click the "Send Money" tab.
- 3. Enter the email as the one you are sending your money to as fundraising@eastlakeband.com and enter amount of payment.
- 4. Click on the "Personal" tab, rather than the "Purchase" tab.
- 5. Select "Payment Owed."
- 6. After you select "continue", please scroll down to the "Message" box and type what your payment is for (i.e. Johnny Smith's Fair Share contribution).

By using your own account and that "personal" tab, we save 2.2% plus 30 cents per transaction. While it doesn't seem like a lot but when we have large payments coming in, it adds up quickly (On a \$500 payment we would save \$11.30). Every penny saved helps the overall cause.
